Description:

Learn the airfare terms, codes, fare construction principles and fare application rules necessary to find, interpret and apply the lowest applicable fare to your client's air itinerary. Practice the interpretation of the multiple air transportation taxes and fees applicable to air travel. Airfares are historically difficult to interpret and apply. This course presents the basics in a simple format with many applications to allow you to become proficient.

Objectives:

You will be able to utilize displays in Computer Reservations Systems to:

- Define domestic fare terms
- Interpret fare basis codes
- Interpret and apply domestic fare and rule displays
- Interpret and explain domestic PNR linear fare calculation lines
- Interpret tax and fee calculations
